You can come in over the summer on Tuesdays, between, 8:00 am - 12:00 pm to take the AR test. A/R will only be from June 7 - July 26 and an appointment must be made. Remember, if you have already taken the AR test for a particular book, you can't take it again. Be sure to choose a different novel.
