The grade will count as a test grade for the first quarter AND the points earned will count toward your first quarter AR point requirement. *You can come in over the summer on Tuesdays, between 8:00 am - 11:30 am to take the AR test. AR will only be available until July 25. Email [officemanager@adventschoolboca.org](mailto:officemanager@adventschoolboca.org) to let Kelly know you are coming in. Over the summer, the office personnel CANNOT override the AR test for a book not on your level.* Remember, if you have already taken the AR test for a particular book, you can't take it again. Be sure to choose a different novel. If you don't come in over summer, you can take it when school begins. **DO NOT COMPLETE THE ATTACHED ASSIGNMENT FOR BOOK 2.**
