2- One Book from the *Who Was...? Biography series*, by various authors. The Who Was... series of biographies are an interesting way for children to learn about important people in history. The text is easy to read, detailed enough to provide insight into the person's life, and full of black and white illustrations to help children remember visually what they read. Once you have completed the reading assignment, you will design and create a visual display of your selected person. Your display should have at least 5 facts about your famous person.
